Why The NWH Group

Challenges Faced by Miller Homes

Under the direction of their Construction Director, Neil Goodall, Miller Homes sought to improve waste management practices across their sites. Key challenges included:

- Inert Waste Reduction: The client required a significant reduction in the amount of inert materials ending up in mixed construction skips.
- Data-Driven Decision-Making: Miller Homes needed detailed and consistent reporting to monitor waste segregation and site performance.
- Operational Efficiency: Ensuring site operatives were correctly segregating and fully utilising skips to minimise unnecessary waste.

Solutions Delivered by The NWH Group

To address these challenges, the NWH Group implemented a range of targeted solutions:

Site Monitoring & Education:

- Conducted site visits to observe waste segregation practices.
- Held multiple meetings with Miller Homes' Construction and Technical Directors to align on goals and strategies.
- Supplied colour-coded tipper skips (e.g., for inert, wood, plasterboard) to simplify segregation for site personnel.
- Supported on-site education initiatives by providing materials and attending sessions to share insights.

Customised Reporting:

- Provided detailed monthly transaction reports, highlighting site averages and anomalies.
- Delivered weekly updates during the trial phase for focused sites, helping identify trends and areas for improvement.
- Innovative Cost Management:
- Segregated waste streams to reduce contamination, leading to significant cost savings (e.g., cheaper rates for segregated wood waste versus mixed skips).
- Ensured skips were fully utilised before collection, minimising inefficiencies and additional costs.















Tangible Outcomes

Since implementing these initiatives in April 2023, the partnership has achieved remarkable results:

- Improved Waste Segregation: Site operatives now consistently separate waste streams, resulting in cleaner skips and fewer instances of contamination.
- Increased Recycling Rates: Recycling rates across Miller Homes' North East sites remain at an impressive 90%, supporting their sustainability goals.
- Cost Savings: While specific monetary figures are unavailable, the reduction in contaminated skips and optimised waste management processes have undoubtedly led to significant savings for Miller Homes.
- Operational Efficiencies: Weight averages for skips have decreased, aligning with best practices (e.g. mixed C&D skips at 2.5-3 tonnes, wood skips at 2 tonnes).
